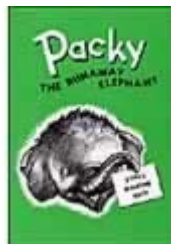

**Packy, the Runaway Elephant**--A baby elephant escapes from the zoo and goes looking for a little girl named Eloise.



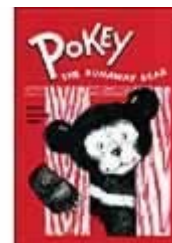
## Pacific Press Launches New Website
